
Electrical Wiring Schematic for Tow Behind Trailers with Electric Brakes

Color Function Gauge White Ground Green Right Turn 14 Yellow Left Turn 14 Brown Tail Lights 14 Red Stop, ABS 10 Electric Brake Power Black 10 Blue Charging, 10



Notes: The Black wire is only used on trailers with electric brakes.

For both air and electric brake trailers, the BLUE wire goes to the battery but keyed through the ignition switch and fused (50 amp) For both air and electric brake trailers, the RED wire goes to the stop light switch.

TL-6 trailers do NOT use the RED stop light circuit wire. The stop light function comes through the Green and Yellow turn signal wires



CAUTION!

Trailers built between October 1, 1993 and February 28, 1998 have the BLUE and the BLACK function are reversed. BLUE for brakes and BLACK for charging.
